



“The gatekeepers were assigned to the four directions: east, west, north, and south... and they had charge over the chambers and treasuries of the house of God, and they lodged all around the house of God because they had the responsibility, and they were in charge of opening it every morning.” 1 Chronicles 9:24-27

Possibly the greatest gate keeper the world has ever seen is the Apostle Paul. “And when they were come, and had gathered the church together, they reviewed all that God had done for them and how He had opened the door of faith to the gentiles.” (Acts 14:27) Talent and ability is not the primary characteristic the Lord is looking for in a gatekeeper, but rather faithfulness.
