



“So Saul died for his unfaithfulness which he had committed against the LORD, because he did not keep the word of the LORD, and also because he had consulted a medium for guidance. But he did not inquire of the LORD; therefore the LORD killed him, and turned the Kingdom over to David, the son of Jesse.” 1 Chronicles 10:13-14
