



“Then all Israel came together to David at Hebron... The LORD your God said to you, “You shall shepherd My people Israel... therefore all the elders of Israel came to the King at Hebron... and they anointed David king over Israel, according to the word of the LORD by Samuel.” 1 Chronicles 11:1-3

Men may make a show. They may “pomp and circumstance” with fanfare and appointments; titles and positions may be sought; votes bought and sold; but after all the smoke clears there is one thing we must always remember – God alone makes kings!
