## Revival

"And Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for there is a sound of abundance of rain. So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees." 1 Kings 18:41-42

Our God "calls those things which be not as though they were." (Romans 4:17) Created in His image and then, once born again recreated in the image of His beloved Son, Jesus Christ, we too, are called to speak to the mountains, the obstacles, the troubles, the challenges before us – "For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be removed, and be cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he says shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he says."
