"And the messenger who was gone to call Micaiah spoke to him, saying, "Behold, now, the words of the prophet declare unto the king with one mouth; let your word, I pray, be like the word of one of them and speak that which is good." And Micaiah said, "As the LORD lives, what the LORD says to me, that will I speak." 1 King 22:13-14
