1 Samuel 1:22-23

"... and then I will bring him, that he may appear before the LORD, and there abide forever. And Elkanah, her husband, said unto her, "Do what seems good... only the LORD establish His word." 1 Samuel 1:22-23

Hannah was a woman of her word. Having vowed before the LORD that should He give her a son she would dedicate him to the LORD "all the days of his life." (1 Samuel 1:11). These days must have been so very precious to her! Days that she knew would come to a close and that her first born must be "lent to the LORD."
