1 Samuel 2:12-18

"Now the sons of Eli were scoundrels, *worthless men*, for they knew not the LORD... But Samuel ministered before the LORD. ." 1 Samuel 2:12-18

Our worth comes not from what we can do or from the number of degrees we may hold behind our name. Neither does the neighborhood we live in or the color of our skin determine our worth. There is a far greater principle at work here. While all men are loved of God and have been valued with an unestimatable cost, that worth is only realized by those who will believe and receive God's most precious gift; Jesus Christ.
