1 Samuel 14:6

"And Jonathan said to the young man who bore his armour, "Come, and let us go over to the garrison of these uncircumcised (*read – men without a covenant*); it may be that the LORD will work for us; for there is no restraint to the LORD to save by many or by few." 1 Samuel 14:6
