2 Chronicles 5:13-14

“It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, saying, “For He is good; for His mercy endures for ever”: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD; So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.” 2 Chronicles 5:13-14

Unity is both precious and powerful! Unity is precious in that when it is present, peace, happiness, and fruitfulness are the direct benefit for all to enjoy. “For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined to his wife, and they shall be one flesh.” (Ephesians 5:30). Unity is powerful in that it opens the realms of the impossible and makes them possible. “Again, I say unto you that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them by My Father, Who is in heaven.” (Matthew 18:19; also see Genesis 11:6).
