2 Chronicles 25:5-10

"Amaziah gathered Judah together... he also hired might men of Israel for a hundred talents of silver... But there came a man of God to him saying, "Let not the armies of Israel go with you, for the LORD is not with Israel. But if you go *with Israel's army* ... God shall make you fall before the enemy..."
