2 Chronicles 32:6-8

“And Hezekiah spoke encouragement to them, saying, “Be strong and courageous, be neither afraid nor dismayed for the King of Assyria, nor for the entire multitude who are with him; for there are more with us than with him. With him is the arm of flesh; but with us is the LORD, our God, to help us, and to fight our battles.” And the people rested themselves upon the words of Hezekiah, King of Judah.” 2 Chronicles 32:6-8

“He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strong in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully persuaded that, what He had promised, He was able also to perform.
