“And Elijah said, “You have asked for a hard thing, nevertheless, if you see me when I am taken from you your request will be answered.” 2 Kings 2:10

“Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think – infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes or dreams.” (Ephesians 3:20 Amplified)

The servant had seen beyond the veil! What other men would consider impossible or relegated to another dispensation, Elisha, said, “I’ll have a double portion, thank you!” (2 Kings 2:9) He wanted enough for two life times! He had seen Yahweh and knew this is the El Shaddai, the God Who is More than Enough. Two portions of miracles, or money, or provision, or blessing would not bankrupt Heaven. There is plenty for all – “nothing lacking.” (see Luke 22:35; James 1:4).
