2 Kings 2:12

“And Elisha saw it!” 2 Kings 2:12

Elisha had seen it for a long time! He was practiced at using his spiritual senses (Hebrews 5:14). No doubt, by faith's eye, had had seen himself walking in Elijah's anointing – that he too, would walk in the miraculous!

We have been schooled from birth in the ways of our flesh. Our sense knowledge far outweighs our spiritual discernment, much to our disadvantage and shame. We have nurtured the natural man's abilities and have determined truth based upon that which we can see, hear, taste, touch or smell. There is a knowing that is far more excellent than what our senses tell us. “But the natural man receives not the things of the Spirit of God; for they are foolishness to him, neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.” (1 Corinthians 2:14)

Whenever we base truth solely upon what men may say, whether these men be the finest doctors, lawyers, scientists, or educators, we cut ourselves off from the Source of all Truth – the Spirit of Truth Who is the Holy Spirit of God. “Nevertheless, when He, the Spirit of Truth comes, He will guide you into all truth, for He will not speak of Himself, but whatever He shall hear, that will He speak and He will show you things to come.” (John 16:13)

Remember, what you detect with your five senses may be real, but it is subject to change. As you begin to exercise your spiritual senses relying more and more upon the Holy Spirit, you too, like Elisha, will “see it!”
