2 Kings 2:14

"And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and struck the waters, and said, "Where is the LORD God of Elijah?" And when he struck the water, it was divided this way and that, and Elisha then crossed over." 2 Kings 2:14

Under the anointing of the Spirit a man will do things that he would never imagine doing in his own ingenuity or strength. Furthermore, what was reckoned impossible in the natural realm becomes possible – and even commonplace – under the power and glory of the Spirit. "For by You I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall." (Psalm 18:29)
