2 Kings 3:16-18

"And he said, "Thus says the LORD, "Make this valley full of ditches." For thus says the LORD, "you shall not see wind, nor shall you see rain yet the valley shall be filled with water, so that you, your cattle, and your animals may drink." "And this is a simple matter in the sight of the LORD; He will also deliver the Moabites into your hand." 2 Kings 3:16-18

Not an unimportant matter to the Lord, but a simple matter! Your back may be up against a wall. Overwhelming odds may be facing you. It's possible even the company you are keeping is not the best. The kings of Israel, Judah and Eden had gathered together to attack Moab, but really only one king was righteous before God and the prophet.
