2 Kings 4:10

“Please, let us make a small upper room on the wall; and let us put a bed for the man of God there, and a table and a chair and a lamp stand; so that whenever he comes to our house, he will have a place to stay.” 2 King 4:10

To what extent will you go to make room for the anointing of God in your life? This most precious of commodities is often the last item upon our list of priorities. This most Holy Guest, the Holy Ghost, is often left out of our plans and pursuits. We give little thought as to how our conduct can make His stay in our hearts and lives more profitable, both for us and for the kingdom of God!

This Shunammite woman understood the importance of having the Anointing abiding under her roof! Today we may make grand gestures concerning our belief in the Anointing, but when it comes right down to it, we harbor petty thoughts and personalized sins that grieve the Holy Spirit. “And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you are sealed unto the day of redemption.” (Ephesians 4:30)

Occasionally it is good to evaluate our lives in light of this thought... do we live in such a way as to bless this most Holy Guest, or do we live in such a compromising way that He would be grieved and saddened by our conduct and thought life?
