“Faith speaks in this way.” Romans 10:6

Religious “speak” is not the language of faith for it is full of men’s ideas and thoughts about God. Usually most of men’s best thoughts about God are carnal, unproductive and irrelevant. Often such thoughts are not even the truth as they are given to feelings and personal opinion. Faith speaks with authority because it is empowered by the Word of God from which it sprang!

The Shunammite’s son, the gift of faith, was dead. (2 King 4:18-21) Yet this mother’s faith was active and alive. Instead of speaking what she knew to be the truth of the circumstance to both her husband and the prophet’s servant, her faith spoke in this way, “It shall be well.” (2 King 4:26). She was speaking concerning the reality, not of the natural things of the world, but she was speaking based upon the Promise of God that had issued forth from Another Realm! Yes, faith speaks. It speaks of our God’s ability and willingness to deliver! It speaks of His compassion and mercy to forgive! It speaks of His stripes by which we are healed! “Faith speaks in this way!”

Faith reckons the answer before it is seen or felt. Faith calls things that are not as though they are already an accomplished fact! Faith speaks in this way. Faith declares the end from the beginning and sees the answer even afar off. Faith agrees with God’s word and refuses to waver in the face of difficulties. “Faith speaks in this way.”

In what manner are you speaking? Are your words religious “speak”, or is the “word of faith near you, even in your mouth”? (Romans 10:8) If all you can see are the problems, chances are you have yet to allow “faith to speak in this way.” Lift up your eyes from the problems you face and begin to allow “faith to speak in this way.”
