2 Kings 7:3 – 4

“And *the four lepers* arose at the entrance of the gate; and they said to one another, “Why are we sitting here until we die? If we say, ‘we will enter into the city, the famine is in the city and we shall die there. And if we sit here, we will die also. Therefore, come, let us surrender to the army of the Syrians. If they allow us to live, we shall live, and if they kill us, we shall only die.” 2 Kings 7:3 – 4

Christian friend, is this your attitude about living – “For if we live, we live for the Lord; or if we die, we die for the Lord; therefore whether we live or die, we are the Lord’s”? (Romans 14:8)
