“So David knew that the Lord had established him as king over Israel... ..And more sons and daughters were born to David.” 2 Samuel 5:12-13

You may have many promises from God, many prophecies and even endorsements from men, but until there is a knowing in your own heart that those things promised are for you, you will always, to a degree, be on the outside looking in.
