And further, such gifts may begin to cloud your unbiased judgment. It is not your place to play favorites. (James 2:19).

"But Abram said to the king of Sodom, "I have raised my hand to the LORD God Most High, the Possessor of heaven and earth, that I will take nothing from a thread to a sandal strap and that will not take anything that is yours, lest you should say, "I have made Abram rich..." (Genesis 14:22 - 23).

"My son, trust in the LORD alone. Look to His hand not a man's hand for your provision. He will not fail you, and in so doing, you will have "possessed your own soul."
