"And you, his son, O Belshazzar, have not humbled your heart, though you know all of this – and you have lifted yourself up against the Lord of heaven." Daniel 5:22 – 23

Humility is a choice! In fact, it is unscriptural to pray for humility. Now, we may need to ask the Lord's grace and His help in making the right choices, but don't ever be deceived – humility is a choice – a decision we must make. "When you are invited to a wedding ... sit in the back or in the lowest of seats... for who ever exalts himself shall be ashamed, and he that humbles himself shall be exalted." (Luke 14:7 – 11)

"Father, in Jesus' name, help me this day to walk with You in humility of heart and mind. Let me see, ahead of time, the opportunities to sit with You in the back rather than sit in the front with others. I want to choose wisely, I want to choose humility!"
