

Volume 3 The Prophetic Books Daniel 9:9 - 11

"To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against Him. We have not obeyed His voice... therefore the curse... written in the Law of Moses has been poured out on us, because we have sinned against Him." Daniel 9:9 – 11

Let's cut to the chase!

Obedience brings the blessing of God.

Disobedience brings the curse of the Law.

How elementary, yet we have a most difficult time it seems grasping this concept, don't we?! "If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land; but if you refuse and rebel, you shall be devoured by the sword." (Isaiah 1:19 – 20).
