Haggai 1:2 – 4

"This people are saying, "The time isn't right, we had better wait on the LORD for His perfect timing to rebuild the temple. But the Lord responds sarcastically by saying, "O, but it is time for you to live in custom homes while My house lies waste?" Haggai 1:2 - 4 author's paraphrase.

We may talk the talk, but it is in our service to other people that our true Christian character and spirit is seen. It is so easy to talk of our devotion to God but such devotion is proven in our daily lifestyle! (1 John 3:16 - 18; 4:7 - 11).
