

Volume 3 The Prophetic Books Isaiah 6:6 – 7

'Then flew one of the seraphim unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, "Lo, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged." Isaiah 6:6 – 7

Encounters with the Lord, while revealing of our own sinfulness are never intended solely to merely reveal our sin, but are designed (if we will respond appropriately) for us to know and realize His redemptive kindness!

Without first the revelation of our wicked hearts, we can never fully embrace His redemption for there will always be a hidden sense that we can achieve Heaven's glories on our own merit – such is the hideous and deceptive nature of sin!

To stand in God's presence is to stand naked before His glorious light with every sin and evil thought, motive and intention of the heart (whether for good or bad) fully and completely exposed! "Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in His sight, but all things are naked and opened unto the eye of Him with whom we have to do. " (Hebrews 4:13).

Having had the heart bared along with Isaiah, we are now ready to receive God's solution to our sin problem – placing our trust and faith solely in the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. "Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way, which He has consecrated for us, through the veil that is to say His flesh, and having a high priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience." (Hebrews 10:19-20).

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new." (2 Corinthians 5:17).
