Isaiah 6:8

"... I heard the voice of the LORD, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who shall go for us?" Then I said, "Here I am, send me." Isaiah 6:8

To respond to the call of God before you have experienced His redemption in a personal way is to attempt to enter the sheepfold unlawfully. (John 10). But now, having seen your own personal sinfulness and having repented of the same; having received of His forgiveness and mercy extended to you by Jesus Christ; you are now able to hear and respond to the will of God.

Now, be forewarned. To hear the call of God is not the same as responding to the call of God. "For many are called, but few are chosen." (Matthew 20:16).
