Isaiah 40:28; 31

"Have you not known? Have you not heard? That the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, faints not, *and* neither *does He grow* weary? There is no searching of His understanding." Isaiah 40:28.

As the revelation of this verse dawns within your heart, faith will leap! What can tire Him? Who can tax His strength and abilities? Don't you know? There is none capable of plumbing the depths of His understanding!
