"Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me, declaring the end *and the results* from the beginning and from ancient times things which have not been done, Saying, 'My purpose will be established, and I will accomplish all My good pleasure..." Isaiah 46:9 – 10 NASB
