

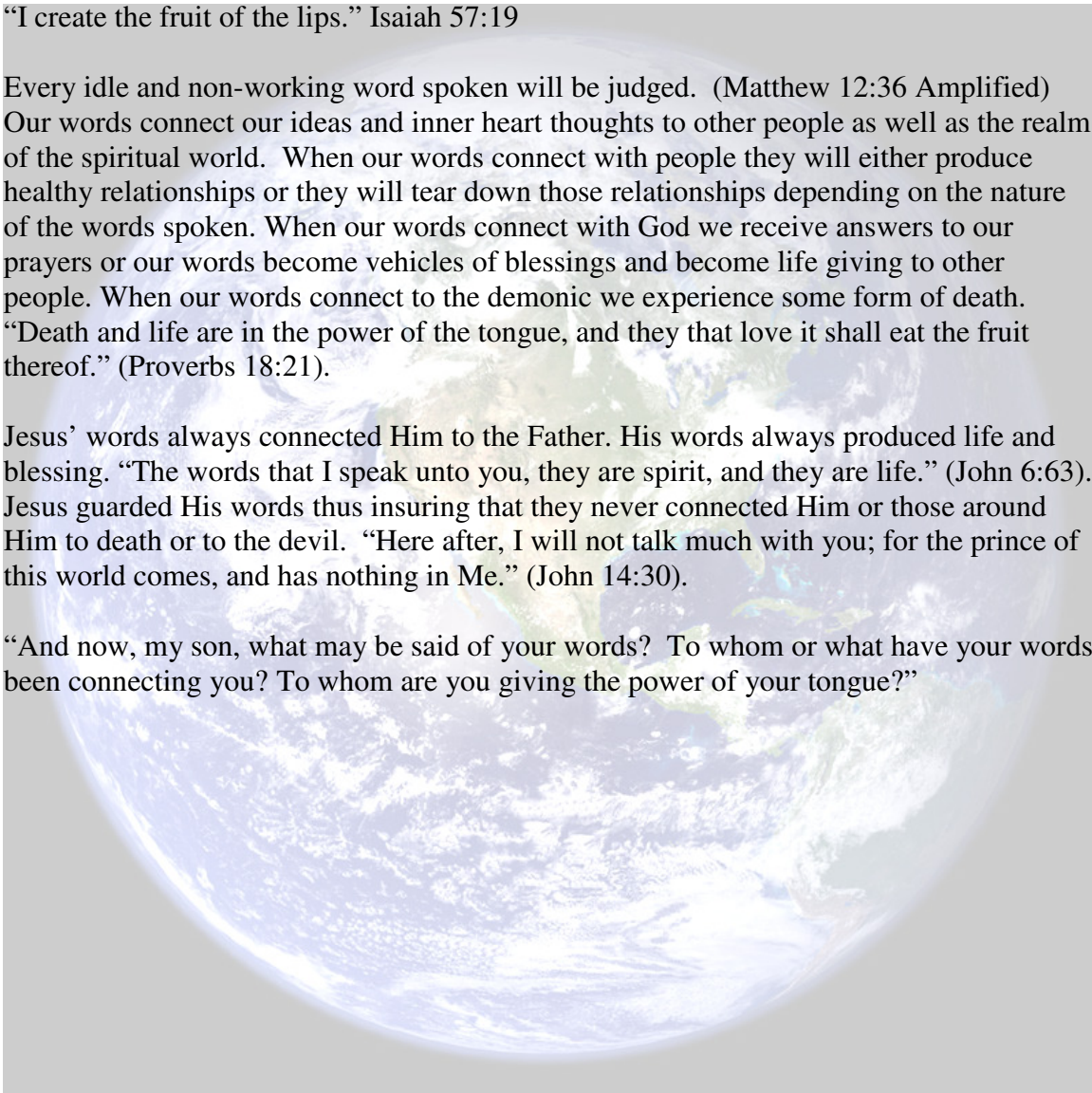


“I create the fruit of the lips.” Isaiah 57:19
