

Volume 3 The Prophetic Books Isaiah 66:2

"... but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and *who* trembles at My Word." Isaiah 66:2

What does it mean; "The Lord is not a respecter of persons?" Haven't we misunderstood that to mean God doesn't play favorites; that He offers no one special treatment for one person over another? In the sense that He loves all people equally and that His desire is that none perish, this is true. But, as shocking as it may be, God does respond to certain people over others!
