"Then Job answered and said, "... O that I knew where I might find Him that I might come even to His seat? ... Will He plead against me with His great power? No, but He could put strength in me... Behold, I go forward, but He is not there; and backward, but I cannot perceive Him... But He knows the way I take; when He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold." Job 23:1-10

Rarely does a sovereign extend an open invitation for "just anyone to come and have an audience before their Person." Yet the Sovereign Lord God has done just that in the Person of Jesus Christ. "Come unto Me, all you that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11:28)

The face of God is seen alone in the face of His Son, Jesus Christ – in whom, "dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily." Yes, Jesus alone is the way to find God, there is no other!
