"And job answered the Lord, and said, I know that You can do everything, and that no thought can be withheld from You." (Job 42:1-2)

Of course, God can do everything! The prophet Jeremiah uttered the same affirmation when he said, "Ah, Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Thy great power and outstretched arm and there is nothing too hard for Thee." (Jeremiah 31:17) The New Testament writer joins his agreement by asserting the words of the angel Gabriel, "For with God nothing shall be impossible." (Luke 1:37).
