"Lord, just let me die. It would be far better to die than continue living – especially when everyone thinks now that I'm a false prophet!" Jonah 4:3 Author's paraphrase.

Anger is a simple matter of you not getting your own way! It is about blocked goals and dreams. It is about frustrated longings and the inner belief that you deserve better treatment than you are presently receiving – from the waitress in the restaurant, the manager on your project, your wife or husband, at home with your parents... or even by the Lord!

Such childish, selfish anger, cries out that if it cannot have its own way it would be better off to die! "Since life is to revolve around my wishes, if I can't have what I want, what is the use of living? I'll show them!" Selfishness of the highest order!
