Let us not be weary in well doing; for in due season we shall reap (whatever we have sown), if we faint not.” (Galatians 6:7 – 9).

Never then say, “God favours evil doers.” In His time they will all reap a harvest fitting of what they’ve sown. It is up to you to sow good seeds. And it is up to you to also sow seeds of trust in God despite how things may appear!

“LORD I apologize for my wrong thinking and for my words of unbelief. Please forgive me. I affirm that I believe You will do what is right! Every seed sown in this life will produce a harvest. May I be about the business of those seeds I’ve sown and leave the seeds and harvests of others to Your wisdom and justice! In Jesus’ name! Amen”
