

Volume 3 The Prophetic Books Micah 6:3 – 4

"O My people, what have I done to you? And in what way have I wearied you? Testify against Me. ...for I redeemed you..." Micah 6:3-4.

It is easy to do... When faced with seemingly overwhelming struggles – either from external sources or only from within our own hearts – it is all too easy to forget that we are the redeemed of the Lord and that these trials are only temporary! They will pass and we will stand in a wondrous place, fully knowing as are now known by God!

Guard yourself in these times. Resist the temptation to accuse God of not loving you or of not caring about you. For God cannot be tempted with evil, neither does He tempt any man." (James 1:13).

Don't say it! Don't say God is causing this evil that's attacked your family. Don't say it. Don't say that God is keeping you from joy, prosperity and blessing! Don't say it!

"The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give life in all its fullness." (John 10-:10 NLT)

The devil is bad. And God is good! Never accuse God of evil doing! Never, ever!

Such accusations toward God are rooted in selfishness and immaturity. Friends, it is time to grow up, it is time to progress into the things of the Kingdom! It is time to leave certain ways of thinking behind and press on to fully know the Lord!

If you don't understand what is going on in your life, ask for wisdom. (James 1:2-8). And if you don't know what to say, simply speak out these words, "Lord, while I don't understand what is going on, I believe You are a good God and I set my heart, my mind, my will, and my emotions in agreement with You! Lord, I agree with You!"

"For the LORD is good, and His mercies endure forever!" (Say it out loud.)

"Surely God will do me good." (Again, say it out loud.)
