



“Hear then what Wisdom is saying...” Proverbs 8:13 – 21

“When you fear and reverence the LORD you naturally will begin to hate what is evil. Pride and arrogance, along with every evil manner, not to mention perverted talking – all of these things you too will begin to hate, just as the Lord hates them. Ah, but to love God is to love wisdom. Wisdom, like Jesus, is found by those who are hungry and thirsty for it. The cry of the human heart calls to a God Who is Himself longing to reveal His salvation to all people.
