"The blessing of the LORD, it makes *one* rich, and He adds no sorrow with it." Proverbs 10:22

The Bible is an intensely practical book. It is not just a book about heaven, nor about those oddball sorts that "have nothing better to do than sit around all day and read it." Though it is the Redemptive story of God's great love for mankind, it is not only a book of eternal or heavenly things. The Bible speaks to our day to day living and our day to day loving. It instructs us to have happy and obedient children. It calls us to higher standards in our relationships both in the marketplace and at home. And the man became great, and grew richer, until he became very wealthy." (Genesis 26:12 – 14).

"...and He adds no sorrow with it." The Father's heart toward you is not harsh, neither is it unkind. Some folks believe that when a blessing comes into their lives, for some reason God must then balance it out with hardship or trial. Listen friend that is not the nature of God – His thoughts toward you are for good – His gifts are good gifts! (Jeremiah 29:11; James 1:17; Luke 11:11 – 13)

The blessing of the LORD that makes you rich is a covenant right. It has been procured by the death and resurrection of His Son, Jesus Christ. It is received by faith and to be used for His glory – free of sorrow! (Romans 8:32)
