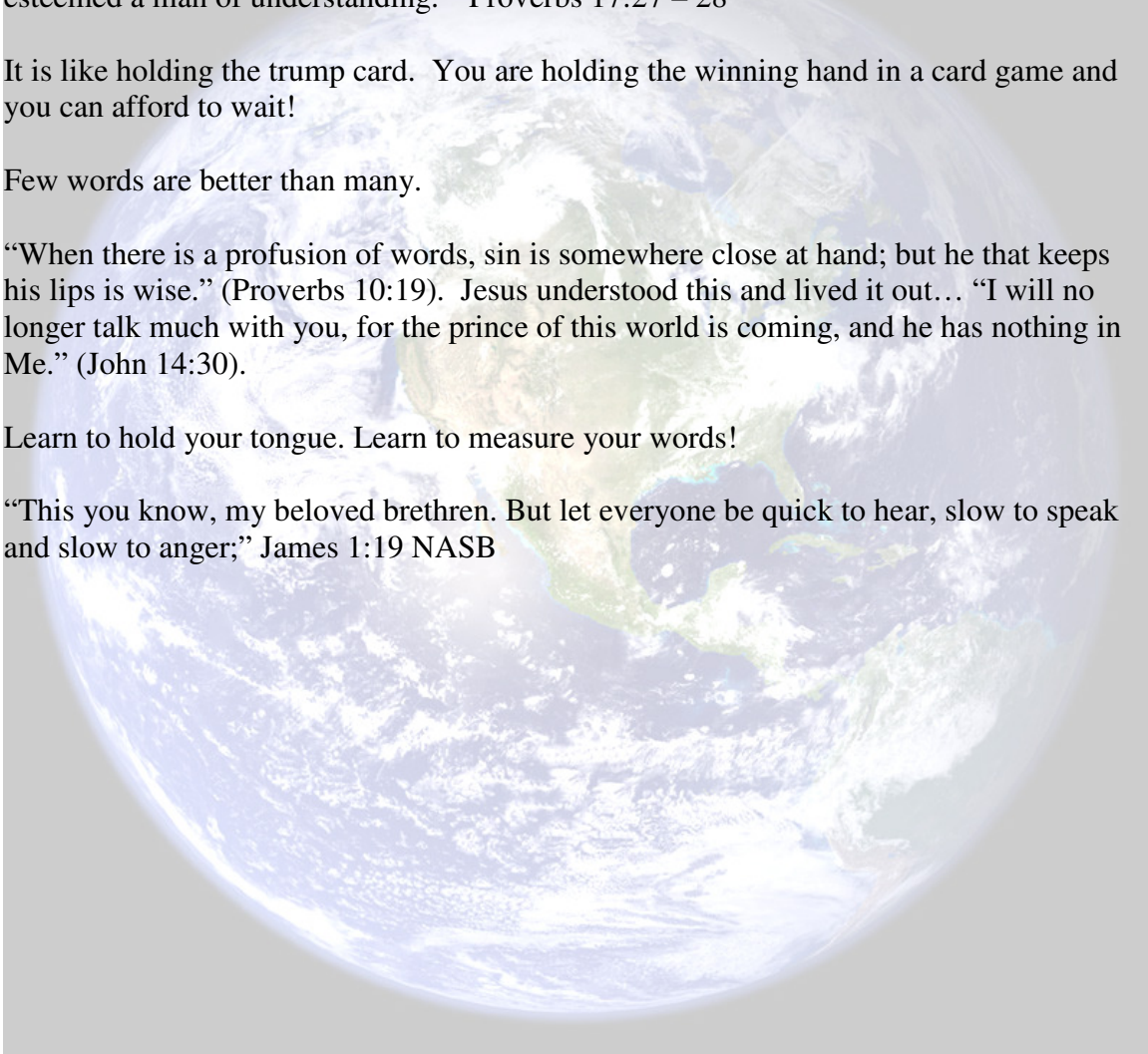
It is like holding the trump card. You are holding the winning hand in a card game and you can afford to wait!
