Psalm 15:1

"LORD, who shall abide in Your tabernacle? Who shall dwell in Your holy hill?" Psalm 15:1

What is the difference from those who merely visit and those who come to stay? "He that walks uprightly and works righteousness, and speaks the truth in his heart." (Psalm 15:2). To exact such payments from your brother excludes your right to live in His Presence! "Freely, you have received, freely give." (Matthew 10:8).

"He that does these things shall never be moved." (Psalm 15:5b).
