"I would have lost heart, unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. Wait on the Lord – be of good courage and He shall strengthen your heart – wait I say, on the LORD." Psalm 27:13 – 14

But when he saw the boisterous waves he was afraid; and he began to sink..." Peter was losing heart quickly. But in that trial he quickly refocused his faith upon the Lord Jesus and in so doing experienced a great victory! "Lord save me!" And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand, and caught Him." (Matthew 14:29—31).

Refocus your faith! Set your eyes on Jesus! Trust in His Word. When you plant yourself firmly on God's eternal Word, you'll come through any and every storm, more than a conqueror! Continue believing! Continue trusting that you will see the deliverance, the provision, the blessing of God in the now – in the land of the living!

"LORD, lift me up from the pit of despair. Set my feet firmly on Your promises. I believe that I will live to see and experience, for myself, Your goodness! I expect it, I receive it, I thank You for it! In Jesus' name!"
