



The Psalm of Safety!

“Because you have made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, your habitation; there shall no evil befall you, neither shall any plague come near your dwelling. For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways. They shall bear you up in their hands, lest you dash your foot against a stone. You shall tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shall you trample under feet.” Psalm 91:9 – 13

“Lord God, open my spiritual eyes that I might see as Elisha and the young man saw. Give me eyes to see and ears to hear the supernatural, give me discernment that I might have Your wisdom to make righteous judgments. Give me courage to face my worst enemies without fear or hatred.
