"The LORD reigns; He is clothed with majesty... Your throne is established of old; You are from everlasting. The floods have lifted up, O LORD, the floods have lifted up their voice, and the floods have lifted up their waves. The LORD on high is mightier than the voice of many waters, yes, than the mighty waves of the sea." Psalm 93:1 – 4
