"Bless the LORD, you His angels that excel in strength, that do His commandments, hearkening to the voice of His Word." Psalm 103:20

These beings from the heavenly realm are both awesome in sight and in deed. These angels are so glorious in appearance that when they are seen of men, it is a natural response for those men to often fall at their feet and attempt to worship them. (Revelation 22:8-9).
