"Until the time that his word came *to pass*; the Word of the LORD tested him." Psalm 105:19

Do you have promise from God? Of course you do – even if it is the most basic and fundamental promise of all – "God is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance!" (2 Peter 3:9; John 3:16).

Whenever the Word of God – the Promise of God – is sown into a human heart, it is challenged by the devil. Though challenged, world overcomers will pass these tests! There is too much at stake to fail. You have no options – the Greater One indwells you! (1John 4:4). You are an over comer because you've trusted in Jesus! (1 John 5:4-5). Set your sights upon eternal things and prepare yourself to reign with Jesus! (Romans 5:17; Revelation 2:7, 11, 17, 26, 3:5, 12, 21).
