"His heart is established; he shall not be afraid..." Psalm 112:8

The times in which we are living are fearful times! Jesus said that during the Ending Days men's hearts would fail them because of fear! (Luke 21:26). Such reliability offers the child with great and real sense of security deep within their own hearts.
