Psalm 119:1 – 7

“Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the LORD. Blessed are they that keep His testimonies and that seek Him with the whole heart. They *that* do no iniquity: they walk in His ways. You have commanded us to keep Your precepts diligently. O that my ways were directed to keep Your statutes! Then shall I not be ashamed, when I have respect unto all Your commandments. I will praise You with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned Your righteous judgments.” Psalm 119:1 – 7
