Psalm 119:67 – 68

"Before I was afflicted I went astray; but now have I kept Your word. You are good, and do only good; teach me Your statutes." Psalm 119:67 – 68

Thinking the affliction is God's way of getting their attention they are unaware of all the better things and methods the Lord was using to gain their attention.

A question then arises for us – if we would respond quicker to the Holy Spirit's voice in His Word, would we need to face so many afflictions? Whatever the answer, a famed missionary to China said something we should never forget...

"It doesn't matter, really, how great the pressure is; it only matters where the pressure lies. See that it never comes between you and the Lord – then the greater the pressure, the more it presses you to His breast." Hudson Taylor
