"Therefore, whosoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man, who built his house upon a rock. And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat upon that house but it didn't fall; for it was founded upon a rock." (Matthew 7:24 – 25)
