So don't be surprised. "Marvel not, my brethren, if the world hates you." (1 John 3:13). "If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you." (John 15:18).

My sons, It is easier to take a stand from the beginning of any relationship than to try and ease into being a Christian a little at a time. You needn't always preach, but once you have taken your stand, everyone will soon know why you are acting differently. They will either respect your integrity, or will begin to attempt to "prove" your mettle!

Stand strong in Christ, be bold, love unconditionally, and stay sweet! Looking always to Jesus!
