Psalm 140

"Rescue me, O LORD, from evil men; Preserve me from violent men, who devise evil things in their hearts; they continually stir up wars. They sharpen their tongues as a serpent; *the* poison of a viper is under their lips. Selah. Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; Preserve me from violent men, who have purposed to trip up my feet. The proud have hidden a trap for me, and cords; They have spread a net by the wayside; they have set snares for me." Selah. I said to the LORD, "Thou art my God; Give ear, O LORD, to the voice of my supplications. O GOD the Lord, the strength of my salvation, Thou hast covered my head in the day of battle.
