“The King has brought me into His chambers.” Song of Solomon 1:4b

This place of intimacy with the Lord is a rare occurrence – not because God does not desire it, but rather because people are not ready for it or even expecting such a “close encounter” of the God-kind! This encounter is so close that He desires to wipe the tears from your eyes!

There are however other legitimate and very real places of fellowship with the Lord Jesus. There is the Emmaus Road experience. (Luke 24:13 – 32). This is a place of revelation, a place of seeing Him as He is; it is a place of having the “eyes of our understanding opened.” (Ephesians 1:17).

The place of revelation frees us from the legalism of men and the efforts of our own hearts. Revelation issues from the Father’s initiation and breaks forth in our hearts with such force that we move from the place of doubt and confusion to the place of faith and knowing! This revelation will establish and settle our position in God. The historical Christ becomes the Personal Saviour in this place of revelation.

“Who do men say that I, the Son of Man am? “...Peter answered and said, “You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.” Then Jesus answered Peter with these words, “You are blessed Peter, for flesh and blood (*your effort or independent thinking*) has not revealed this to you, but My Father Who is in heaven.” (Matthew 16:13 – 19).

And so in this place on the Emmaus Road you too, will have the opportunity to experience Jesus... “Then their eyes were opened, and they knew Him... and they said to one another, “Did not our hearts burn within us ...while He opened the Scriptures to us?” (Luke 24:31 – 32).

“Spirit of the Living God, teach me of the Saviour on this road of revelation.”
